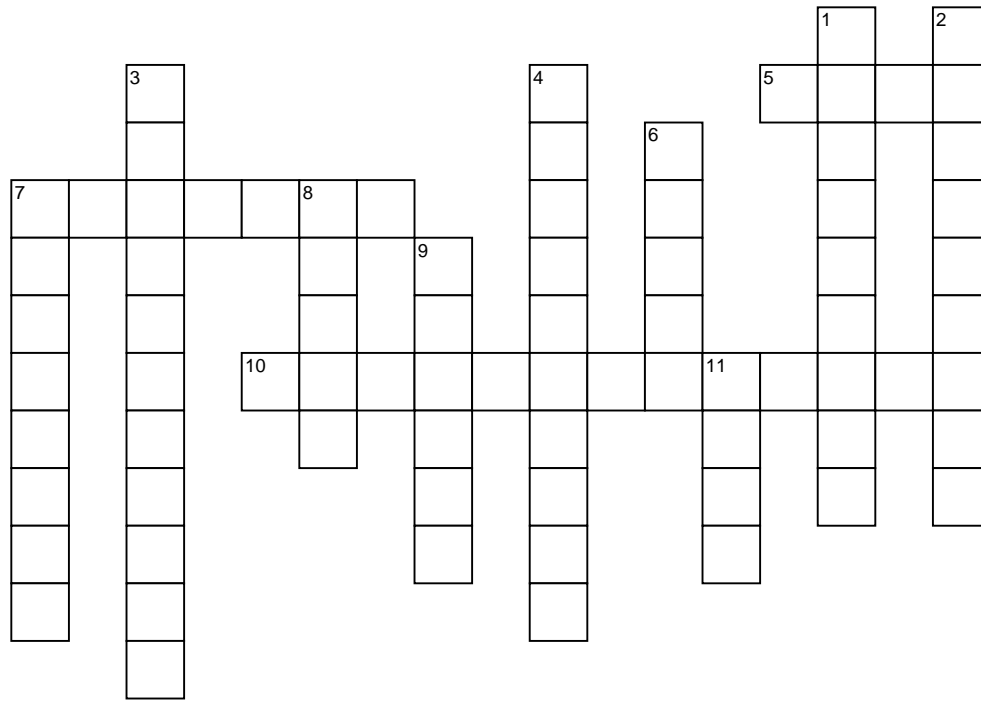


# DCS Comp. 6.01 Spreadsheet Vocabulary



## ACROSS

- 5 intersection of a row and column and is identified by a cell reference (B4)
- 7 equations with symbols for math operations. An example is  $=B6+B7+B8=B9$
- 10 the column letter and the row number

## DOWN

- 1 a selected group of cells that form a rectangle
- 2 when data is entered into a cell, the default alignment is labels to the left and values to the right
- 3 a program that allows you to use rows and columns of data to manage and present information
- 4 the cell ready for data entry
- 6 a number entered into a spreadsheet cell that will be used for calculations.
- 7 special formulas that do not use operators to calculate a result; a shortcut formula. An example is  $=SUM(A6:A9)$
- 8 text, symbols, dates, or numbers not used in calculations
- 9 identified by letters that appear at the top of the spreadsheet (vertical)
- 11 identified by numbers on the left side of the spreadsheet (horizontal)
